A few points about the year ahead:

Water bottles – Please can children bring in their own water bottles which they can keep on their tables throughout the day for easy access. I have a few spare water bottles, so please message if you would like your child to use one of these.

PE and Forest School – Ash will have PE for an hour on Monday afternoons and Friday morning. We also have our Forest School afternoon on Fridays. Please can children wear full PE kits on Mondays and PE tops with leggings/joggers on Fridays so that children are ready for PE and Forest School.

Reading books – Book change day for Ash is on Tuesdays. However, please ensure that books bags and reading diaries are brought in every day. I will send out more information regarding reading in the next week.

Spellings – Spelling checks for Ash Class will be on Mondays. Please ensure that spelling books are brought in every Monday for the check, and so that new spellings for the week after can be stuck in as well.
